Our Mission:

As an extension ministry of Concord UMC, the Garden of Concord seeks to share God's creation with our neighbors by providing purpose and produce through garden stewardship.

Our Membership:

Members of the garden are not required to be members of our church; anyone from the community or any other church is invited to join our garden. All ages are welcome! There are many tasks for every level and like! Members of our garden are asked to be mindful that their personal behavior and all social interaction with other garden and church members, and the community at large, conforms to Christian ideals of love, mutual respect, and non judgment of one another.

Our Methods:

Our garden is an all inclusive community garden which means that we work together on planned garden tasks as instructed by the garden coordinator. We do not use any chemical fertilizers or pesticides. We welcome the bugs (the good ones!). We use only hand tools, make our own compost (no animal manures), and we do not till our raised beds (so please don't walk on them!) It is suggested that members bring their own bottled water, sunscreen, and insect repellent. The church restrooms are always available for use. Children are encouraged to garden with their parents (and be supervised by them for their safety).

Our Means:

"We plant the seeds...and God makes them grow." (1 Cor 3:6). Concord UMC graciously provides the ground, water, electric, and ministerial interns. Our garden is responsible for the purchase of seeds, supplies, and structures through membership fees, fundraisers, and donations from garden angels!
